NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) and the University of Minnesola will hold a public meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 19, 2011 at the Rosemount Community Center, 13885 South Robert Trail, Rosemount, MN for the purpose of reviewing the draft Remedial Investigation Work Plan (RJ Work Plan) prepared and submitted by the University of Minnesota to the MPCA with respect to the eastern portion of the University of Minnesota Outreach, Research and Education (UMore) Park located in the city of Rosemount and Empire Township, Dakota County Minnesota (Site). The Site includes the industrial section of the former Gopher Ordinance Works, a smoke-less gunpowder production facility owned, constructed and operated by the federal government during World War II. Since its acquisition by the University in 1947 and 1948, the Site has been used for University agricultural and other research projects and tenant agricultural and com-mercial activities. The RI Work Plan includes soil and groundwater sampling in areas of known or suspected releases identified in the Phase I Environmental Assessment of the Site ("Phase I ESA"). The Phase I ESA, RI Work Plan and supporting documents, and other environmental re-ports regarding the Site are available for public review at the Information Repository established by the University, which is located at the UMore Park Administration Office, 1605-160th Street W, Rosemount, MN 55068, and on the UMore Park web site: http://www.umorepark.umn.edu. The MPCA will accept public comments to the RI Work Plan for thirty (30) days from May 9, 2011 through June 10, 2011.
